### PROPOSAL CRITERIA

Authors are required to submit four (4) copies of their proposal, which includes:

- **Title Page** with
  - Author identification
  - Institutional affiliation
  - Verification of current Delta Upsilon Chapter at – Large Membership
- **Abstract** of 250 words
- **Proposal** which includes:
  - Purpose and Objective
  - Significance of problem for nursing with relevant literature review
  - Theoretical framework
  - Research methods including
    - ♣ Design
    - ♣ Procedure
    - ♣ Data analysis
  - Implications for Practice
- **Budget**  
Breakdown of items, equipment or personnel costs. These must be directly related to the conduction of the research.
- **Human Subject Approval**  
Awards are contingent on authors obtaining institutional review.

**Please Note:** *Proposals exceeding 5 pages (excluding title page, abstract and references) will not be reviewed.*

### EVALUATION CRITERIA

The overall objective is to evaluate each proposal on its scientific merit and significance for nursing practice.

#### Criteria for Evaluation

- Relevance of area for nursing
- Adequacy of conceptual base and literature review.
- Soundness of method design and it's appropriateness to the research question

- Overall scientific merit
- Feasibility of study

### **EXPECTATIONS OF AWARD RECIPIENTS**

- Attend award ceremony
- Submission of a report to chair (9-12 months post award) which documents progress, findings, publications, or presentations.
- Acknowledgement of Delta Upsilon Chapter at – Large in any presentation/publication.
- If a study has not been started by one year post award, authors are expected to write to Research Committee outlining problems, and pending a discussion and decision by the committee, funds may be withdrawn.
- Awardees will be asked to submit an application to the Virginia Henderson Library at International's headquarters. Application letters will be included in the award letter
